Thank You

This is to follow up on the refurbishment project on the sanctuary. As you may recall when we sold the property at 210 S. Randolph Street. The proceeds were to be used to refurbish the sanctuary, pay off the print shop debt and to reimburse the Ruble fund with as much as possible to bring it back to its original amount of \$50,000. We are pleased to report that the refurbishment project came in under budget, the print shop debt has been retired providing an additional \$1,300 a month to our unrestricted offering and we were able to return \$40,000 to the Ruble fund bringing that total up to \$42,000.
