Project Horizon is partnering with the forensic nursing staff at Augusta Health to provide warm, cuddly robes and gowns for the victims of domestic abuse to wear when they are in the hospital setting. Manly's WMU has been asked to provide 5 (or more) robes for children size 8 – 10. Frances Richardson gave us one pattern that she had used for her own children, but said we could use any similar pattern. We have purchased two more similar patterns to share, as well. If someone would like to donate flannel, please purchase 3 ½ yards. If we have more flannel than seamstresses available, we will give the extra flannel to Project Horizon for others to use. Care Package Collection
