**Our Guest Speaker Today is Chaplain (Colonel) Bob Phillips**

Chaplain (Colonel) Bob Phillips joined the VMI Faculty and Staff in August 2016 after completing over 25 years of active duty service in the U.S. Army. Originally from Long Island, NY, CH Phillips initially commissioned in the U.S. Army as a field artillery officer. In 1990 he left active duty to pursue his seminary degree and then returned to active duty as a chaplain in 1994. His military assignments include the 82nd Airborne Division; 1st Armored Division; 4th Psychological Operations Group; 1st Special Warfare Training Group; XVIII Airborne Corps; The Joint Readiness Training Center; and Headquarters, US Army Forces Command. He was forward deployed with the 160th Signal Brigade in support of operations in Iraq and Afghanistan. Chaplain Phillips holds a Master of Divinity degree from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, a Master of Science degree in Counseling from Columbus State University, and a Master of Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College. He is a VMI alum, graduating in 1987 with a B. A. in Economics. His awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal (4 Oak Leaf Clusters), the Army Commendation Medal (2 Oak Leaf Clusters), the Army Achievement Medal, and the Senior Parachutist Badge. He and his wife Tracy were married in May 1987 (the day after graduation). They have four adult children, Robert, Timothy, Kathryn, and Carolina.
